



Music Director Brian Wright introduces the season:




We've five wonderfully entertaining concerts in store for you this season. Our solo line-up is led by MOS's President, the great pianist John Lill - in his 75th birthday year - playing his (and my) favourite Brahms. There's a very welcome return for popular clarinettist Emma Johnson, with contrasting concertos by Weber and Malcolm Arnold. The acclaimed current BBC Young Musician, 18-year-old Lauren Xhang, plays Rachmaninov's spectacular 3rd Piano Concerto. Plus, two exceptional young artists also return, Kentish-born Callum Smart brings Korngold's beautifully romantic Violin Concerto, and - after his stunning last-minute debut with us last season - Maxim Calver plays Shostakovich's brilliant 1st Cello Concerto.

There are fabulous pieces for MSO's players as well - Richard Strauss' *Ein Heldenleben*, Stravinsky's *Petrushka*, Elgar's *Enigma Variations*, symphonies by Schumann and Tchaikovsky, plus works by Chabrier, Beethoven, Britten, Dukas and Wagner.

So buy your season tickets - excellent value - and spread the word that classical orchestral music is very much alive and well here in the middle of Kent!

John Lill



Beethoven - Overture, Fidelio Schumann - Symphony No.4 Brahms - Piano Concerto No.2

MOS's well-loved and long-serving President, John Lill, is one of our greatest pianists, and his performances and recordings of Brahms have been particularly acclaimed worldwide. Brahms' titanic 2nd Piano Concerto almost uniquely melds the principles of the concerto with the symphony. His mentor, Schumann, provides our "real" symphony, his revolutionarily compact and eloquent 4th. Brahms' other great influence was Beethoven, and we open with the fine overture to his magnificent opera, Fidelio.

Britten - Four Sea Interludes from "Peter Grimes" Weber - Clarinet Concerto No.2 Malcolm Arnold - Clarinet Concerto No.2 Elgar - Enigma Variations

Emma Johnson has been a very popular soloist with MSO for many years. No-one has done more to promote the clarinet than Emma, and she brings both classical-romantic eloquence with Weber's 2nd Clarinet Concerto and some jazzy pizzazz from Malcolm Arnold. Either side there are poignant and fiery seascapes from Benjamin Britten, with his Four Sea Interludes from "Peter Grimes", and Elgar's Enigma Variations. This famous series of musical portraits, featuring Nimrod, is lovingly dedicated to "my friends pictured within".

Dukas - The Sorcerer's Apprentice Rachmaninov - Piano Concerto No.3 Stravinsky - Petrushka

18-year-old Lauren Xhang stunned both judges and audience at the BBC Young Musician competition when winning in 2018. She plays the most technically challenging and exciting of romantic piano concertos, Rachmaninov's 3rd. Elsewhere musical storytelling fills the air. We begin with Dukas' colourful symphonic scherzo, The Sorcerer's Apprentice, and end with Stravinsky's brilliantly orchestrated tale of the ups-and-downs of the puppet Petrushka.

Maxim Calver



Wagner - Overture, Die Meistersinger Shostakovich - Cello Concerto No.1 Tchaikovsky - Symphony No.4

Young Maxim Calver amazed us all last season when he took over as soloist at short notice. He returns with the work originally billed for that concert, Shostakovich's powerful 1st Cello Concerto. Wagner's festive overture to Die Meistersinger is a perfect foil. Tchaikovsky then brings every emotion to the fore in his passionate 4th Symphony. At its heart is his belief in the disruptive power of fate, but as he remarked about the boisterous finale: "If you can find happiness in the joy of others, you can still enjoy life!"
